

## Additional Information Regarding Fees - Little Glendower Nursery

Parents of children aged between three and five are eligible for the Government's basic 15 hours per week Free Early Education Entitlement (FEEE) for the time their child attends Little Glendower Nursery.

While the Government funding helps offset some costs, it does not meet the full expense of a Nursery place at Little Glendower.

We provide a broad, high-quality early years curriculum led by experienced teachers and supported by strong adult-to-child ratios. Children enjoy a rich programme of activities such as music, movement, art, drama, cooking early physical development, creative projects and other exploratory learning experiences. The provision of nutritious snacks, high-quality resources, and the administrative work involved in managing the funding also contribute to the overall cost of delivering our Nursery offer.

To maintain the high standard of care and education that defines Little Glendower, parents contribute an additional fee beyond the FEEE funding. The combination of the Government-funded entitlement and the additional charge constitutes the termly Nursery fee.

Parents who wish to access only a FEEE-funded place, without the additional charge, are advised to contact their local Family Information Service to identify another early years provider offering a fully funded place without supplementary fees.
